Bird Evacuation Kit Checklist



30 Day Supply of Bird Food & Water

(In times of disaster, bird food may be difficult to find in pet stores. Baby food, that is not too high in vitamin and mineral supplements, can be a great substitute for fresh veggies)

Hard-Sided Carrier to Prevent Injury to Wings

(Once settled, move bird into an appropriately sized cage as birds can chew their way out of carriers)



Toys, Newspaper (for clean up), & a Spray Bottle or Battery-Powered Fan

(When temperatures rise, birds can be cooled down by being gently sprayed with a water bottle or attach a battery-powered fan to the outside of their cage)



Pet First-Aid Kit , Medication, Emergency/Vet Contacts & Photo of you with your Bird

(Locate veterinary and boarding facilities outside of your community that are familiar with birds and can assist you in times of disaster)



Towels to Cover your Bird's Cage or Restrain your Bird
