# Licensing FAQs

## Is a license required for my dog or cat?

- All dogs over four (4) months of age are required to be licensed and vaccinated against rabies. Cat licensing services are offered on a voluntary basis for those wishing to register ownership of their cats.

## What is the benefit of licensing my pet?

- Pet licensing helps reunite lost pets with their owners. Additionally, OC Animal Care's *Take Me Home Program* waives fees normally required to redeem dogs or cats when they are currently licensed and picked up within 24 hours.

## When do I have to license my dog?

- Residents owning or having custody of any dog must license the dog within 15 days of acquisition or within 15 days after the license becomes due.

## What do I need to license my dog?

- You will need to provide proof of current rabies vaccination. If your dog is spayed/neutered, you will need to provide proof from your vet to qualify for a licensing discount. Additional discounts may apply to residents who are seniors or active/retired military.
