



SHELTER MODIFICATIONS

In response to the Tustin Hangar Fire
and ongoing local state of emergency

Limited Outdoor Operations

- Adoption visits moved indoors
- Dogs limited to indoor kennel
- Outdoor events cancelled
- Non-essential operations moved indoors

Precautionary Safety Measures

- Masks available for staff, volunteers, and visitors
- Mobile air monitoring
- Fixed-placed monitoring and air quality sampling
- Replaced indoor filters
- Mobile HEPA air filtration
- Onsite debris removal

Shelter Enrichment

- Variety of enrichment, including Kongs
- Kongs are large, durable, rubber chew toys, and are a great tool to help combat kennels stress
- Enrichment tools help reduce noise in the kennel, which can be a stressor
- Mental stimulation to combat boredom for the dogs

Emergency Dog Foster

- Call to action for community to foster large dogs for two weeks
- Opportunity for large dogs to be out of the kennel and in a home
- We provide food and essentials such as a collar, tag, and leash

Animal Transports

- Transport dogs to partner shelters
