**Follow these tips to ensure a safe and happy holiday for you and your pet!**

#### **Bring Your Pets Inside**

The loud noises and flash of the fireworks can cause your pets to get scared and run away. Don't bring your pet along to a firework display; they will feel more safe and secure at home.

#### **Microchip and ID Your Pets**

Make sure your pet has a visible ID tag and a microchip with updated information. If your pet is lost during the festivities, someone will be able to contact you if they find your missing pet.

#### **Provide a Safe and Secured Space**

Have a designated space, such as a quiet room or crate, for your pet. Keep them busy/distracted with Kongs and having the TV on can also help cancel out loud noises.

#### **Exercise Early in the Day**

To help alleviate stress and avoid accidents, walk and play with your pet to tire them out before the fireworks begin. If walking after the festivities, watch out for leftover firework debris.
