


It's Hot Outside!

Watch out for signs of heat stroke in your pet!

SIGNS OF HEAT STROKE

- Excessive Panting & Drooling
- Trouble Breathing
- Discolored Gums
- Mobility Problems
- Elevated Body Temperature
- Lethargy
- Vomiting & Diarrhea
- Seizures
- Unconsciousness



IF YOU SUSPECT YOUR PET IS EXPERIENCING HEAT STROKE:

Contact your vet or local emergency clinic immediately!

Move your pet into a cooler area.

Apply *cool wet towels to their head, neck and chest. *(never use cold or ice water)

Offer your pet small drinks of room temperature water. Do not force them to drink.
