Basic Pocket Pet Evacuation K

Keep at minimum a 2-week supply of food & water

Food should be tightly sealed & rotated every few months to make sure it stays fresh



Your pet can be cooled down by placing frozen water bottles or ice packs in a towel inside their carrier. Provide a little

extra water on those hot days

Pocket Pets are sensitive to high

temperatures!

Have fresh bedding & cleaning supplies on-hand

Have plenty of fresh bedding, trash bags and safe cleaning supplies on hand to ensure your pet's enclosure remains clean and free of odor

Bring food & water bowls. Have a smaller carrier to travel in

Include your pet's name, your name, address and phone number and your veterinarian's contact information
